



DIRECTOR OF COUNSELING SERVICES

Northwestern College has a full-time opening for a director of counseling services to begin in August 2023. The director of counseling services is a leader in promoting campus wide mental health programming. Responsibilities include directing the Wellness Center and supervising staff, providing education for employees and students, responding to crisis situations, and providing professional therapy for residential students.

This salaried position requires 36-40 hours per week during the academic year (mid-August through mid-May), excluding college breaks. Summers are off. Full benefits package included. Position comes with excellent administrative support, professional liability insurance, and paid professional development opportunities.

Qualifications include a master's degree in clinical or counseling psychology, clinical social work, or marriage and family therapy. Must possess Iowa licensure. Preference given to candidates with at least three years post-licensure experience. Candidates should have a vital and vibrant Christian faith, integrated with their approach to and philosophy of counseling, as well as experience with and a passion for college students.
